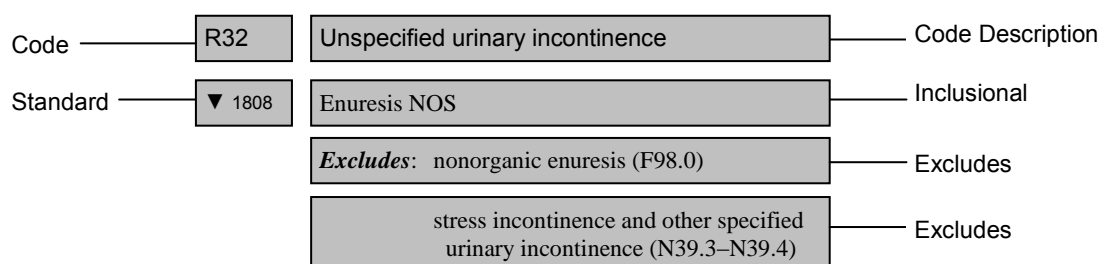

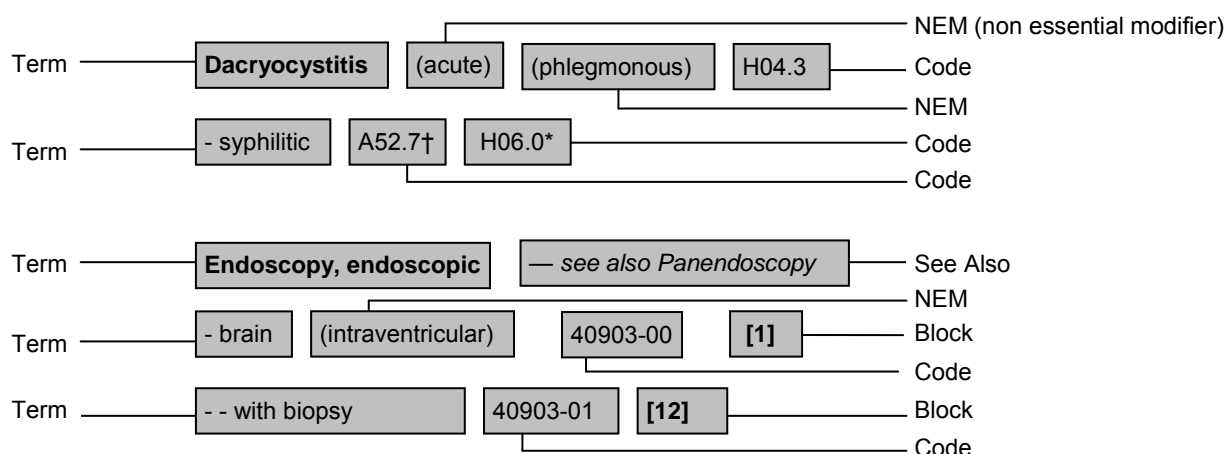

[For combination codes \(see ACS 0015 Combination codes\) where a diagnosis When a single ICD-10-AM code describes multiple concepts \(ie a combination code\) and any concept within that code meets the criteria of COF 1, and is not represented by another code with a COF 1 value, then assign COF 1 to the combination code](#) (see Example 2).

EXAMPLE 11:

Patient admitted with uncontrolled Type 2 diabetes. The patient is known to have nephropathy (CKD stage 3) but no other complications of the diabetes. During admission the patient develops acute kidney failure.

1 – Acute kidney failure

More than one code from E84.- *Cystic fibrosis* should be used if the patient presents with multiple manifestations of CF.

96199-07 [1920] *Intravenous administration of pharmacological agent, nutritional substance* ~~and~~

96199-08 [1920] *Intravenous administration of pharmacological agent, electrolytes* ~~should be assigned when used for management of carbohydrate, hydration or electrolyte disorders.~~

Examples of diagnoses that may require parenteral fluid therapy are 'neonatal hypoglycaemia' (P70.- *Transitory disorders of carbohydrate metabolism specific to fetus and newborn*) or 'other transient neonatal electrolyte disorders' (P74.- *Other transitory neonatal electrolyte and metabolic disturbances*).

Note: These codes should **not be assigned** when these procedures are **part of resuscitation at birth**.

8. Use of the third edition of International Classification of Diseases for Oncology (ICD-O)

For certain morphological types, Chapter 2 provides a rather restricted topographical classification, or none at all. The topography codes of ICD-O use for all neoplasms essentially the same three- and four- character categories that Chapter 2 uses for malignant neoplasms (C00–C77, C80.-), thus providing increased specificity of site for other neoplasms (malignant secondary (metastatic), benign, in situ and uncertain or unknown).

It is therefore recommended that agencies interested in identifying both the site and morphology of tumours, e.g. cancer registries, cancer hospitals, pathology departments and other agencies specialising in cancer, use ICD-O.
