

#### **CLASSIFICATION**

E1-.71 \*Diabetes mellitus with multiple microvascular complications should be assigned when the patient has conditions classifiable to two or more of the following five categories:

- 1. Renal complications (E1-.2-)
- 2. Ophthalmic complications (E1-.31–E1-.35, E1-.39)
- 3. Neurological complications (E1-.41–E1-.43, E1-.49 -)
- 4. Diabetic ischaemic cardiomyopathy (E1-.53)
- 5. One of the following skin or subcutaneous tissue complications (E1-.62):
  - · diabetic:
    - bullae (bullosis diabeticorum)
    - dermopathy (shin spots)
    - erythema
    - rubeosis
  - necrobiosis lipoidica diabeticorum [NLD]
  - periungual telangiectasia(e)

Assign E1-.71 as the principal diagnosis only when no one microvascular complication meets the definition of principal diagnosis.

Additional codes for the specific microvascular complications should also be assigned.
