HOSPITAL ACQUIRED WOUND INFECTION

Definition

A wound infection in a surgical is one from which purulent material drains or is obtained. A reaction around suture material is excluded from the definition and should not be coded.

Classification

In ICD-10-AM, there is no distinction between superficial and deep wound infections, unless the infection is due to or resulting from a prosthetic device, implant or graft. Both superficial and deep wound infections are classified to T81.41 Wound infection following a procedure, not elsewhere classified.
