

The National Hospital Cost Data Collection (NHCDC) is an annual collection of hospital cost data at the line-item level. NHCDC data are provided to the Independent Hospital Pricing Authority (IHPA) from each jurisdiction's Department of Health. The Round 21 NHCDC collected public hospital cost information for the 2016–17 financial year. The NHCDC Cost Report contains detailed summary tables of all reported figures.

What is the cost of Australia's emergency care patients?

Emergency care relates to all services provided to patients in a hospital's emergency department.

Emergency departments are dedicated hospital-based facilities specifically designed and staffed to provide 24 hour emergency care.

IHPA uses the Urgency Related Group (URG) classification system to classify emergency department care provided by Australian hospitals.



The national expenditure on emergency department patient activity was



11.7%

This represents 11.7% of total hospital expenditure reported in Round 21 of the NHCDC.



The data contains detailed cost information for 7,662,322 emergency department presentations.

Of these, 2,333,353 (30%) were subsequently admitted to hospital as either admitted acute care or admitted sub-acute patients.

Taken together, emergency department presentations accounted for 25.4% of all hospital patient activity reported in Round 21 of the NHCDC.

In Round 21, the average cost per admitted ED presentation was \$969. The average cost per non-admitted ED presentation was \$533.
