# Pricing Framework, National Efficient Price and National Efficient Cost Determinations 2023-24

The Independent Health and Aged Care Pricing Authority (IHACPA) was established under the *National Health Reform Act 2011* (Cwlth) to contribute to significant reforms to improve Australian public hospitals. A vital component of these reforms is the implementation of activity based funding for public hospital services.

Each financial year, IHACPA releases the annual national efficient price and national efficient cost to determine the Commonwealth Government's contribution to public hospitals.

The funding is then distributed by the <u>Administrator of National Health Funding Pool.</u>

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For example, a hip replacement (minor complexity) has a weight of 3.9330 NWAU which equates to \$23,724.

## Cost per national weighted activity unit






