For the published hardcopy books, AR-DRG errata may be issued to correct errors and typographical issues that have been identified since the time of publishing. Users are required to incorporate these corrections when using the published hardcopy books.



Major Complexity ECCS ≥ 2.5

Minor Complexity ECCS < 2.5
